ORDINANCE NO. 97-1

The Town of Roxbury, Dane County, ordains as follows:

Section 1. AUTHORITY. The ordinance is enacted pursuant to power granted by virtue of the Wisconsin Statutes, including Section 349.17, <u>Wis. Stats.</u> and town powers. The Town Board finds that a need for this ordinance exists to promote the general public welfare, to protect the public safety from overweight vehicles and to minimize damage to roads maintained by the Town by the establishment of reasonable weight limits for vehicles traveling on roads maintained by the Town.

Section 2. HEAVY TRAFFIC ROUTE ROADS. The following roads are designated heavy traffic route roads, as defined in Section 349.17(1), Wis. Stats.:

- A. Schoepp Road from Mussen Road North to the Columbia County line.
- B. Mussen Road from County Trunk Highway Y North to Schoepp Road.

Heavy traffic route roads shall be marked as required by Section 349.17(1) Wis. Stats.

Section 3. HEAVY TRAFFIC PROHIBITED. Heavy traffic, as defined by Section 349.17(2) <u>Wis. Stats.</u>, shall be prohibited from all other roads maintained by the Town, provided that heavy traffic using such road for the purpose of moving or delivering supplies or commodities to or from any place of business or residence which has an entrance on such road, shall be allowed to use such road.

Section 4. VIOLATION. Any person who owns, or operates, a vehicle in violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture as of not less than \$50.00 for the first violation, nor more than \$100.00 and not less then \$100.00, nor more than \$200.00, for the second violation within a twelve month period.

Section 5. EFFECT. This ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication in a newspaper within 30 days.
