

ROXBURY SANITARY DISTRICT INFLOW & INFILTRATION REDUCTION PROJECT

Project Schedule

Terra Engineering was the low bidder and awarded the contract for the Inflow & Infiltration Reduction Project. Terra is planning to begin work at the end of March (pending weather). They will begin with the manhole rehabilitation, then the mainline lining and the lateral repair/rehabilitation. Property Owners must have their Consent forms or Open Cut Permit Applications & Fees returned by March 19th. The Contractor needs to order each CIPP liner specifically for each property, and needs lead time to do this.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

Schedule: Terra anticipates starting construction at the end of March pending weather with substantial completion by June 30.

Sewer Mains to be Lined:

- Door hanger notices will be handed out the day before lining in front of your property. The door hangers will notify residents of the repair work.
- Work on the lining the sewer main in front of your property should be completed in 1 day.
- Terra asks that high water usage activities be avoided during these time frames since the lateral is blocked at the main. This includes shower/bath, dishwasher, laundry or similar activities. Using the sinks and toilets conservatively during this time frame is OK.
- The liner has odor while curing which residents will smell outside. To help the odor from getting into your home you can make sure drain traps have water in them by pouring a cup or two of water into your drains, especially infrequently used sinks or floor drains where that water may have evaporated over time.

Laterals to be Lined

The contractor will leave a door hanger/notice 24 hours in advance of lining your lateral. The disruption lasts approximately 1.5 hours during installation of the lateral liner. When the contractor is not working on your lateral, there should be no restriction of your water usage.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS (CTH Y Project)

Hwy Y: Resurface KP- Hwy 12

Dane County Highway Department will resurface Hwy Y from KP to 12.

- A new 30 foot wide overlay will be constructed with gravel shoulder widened to accommodate the new 30 foot wide pavement
- 1 large culvert (just west of St. Dominic St.) and 4 small cross culverts will be replaced

Construction Impacts

The road will be closed to thru traffic but open to local traffic. The detour route will be County Road KP south to US 12 and US 12 back to County Road Y.

- There will be daily closures to replace 4 small culverts. These closures will last one day with local traffic being able to cross the replaced culverts at the end of the work day. During the day traffic will need to find an alternative route.
- There is a large culvert just west of the Church that will require the road to be closed for approximately 3 weeks. During this time traffic will need to find alternative routes or follow the marked detour.

Individual Homeowner

- The road will be widened as necessary to accommodate the new pavement. This will mostly impact properties west of the Village of Roxbury. The shoulders east of Roxbury are generally wide enough to accommodate the new pavement
- Minor ditching is expected east of Roxbury at several properties.
- Moderate ditching is expected west of Roxbury due to the widened roadway section.
- No driveway culvert work is anticipated during construction.
- Existing paved driveways in good condition will be milled back or removed a sufficient distance to allow blending with the new pavement. If the pavement is too deteriorated to provide a good edge to match into it will be overlaid to allow blending.
