

The contractor is only lining the mainline at this time, and is not working on any property owner laterals.

The picture below shows the contractor feeding the liner into the manhole, where the liner is inserted in one manhole, and pulled through to the next manhole.



After the liner is in place, the contractor will use steam to cure the liner, and you will see steam coming out of the manholes (as shown in the picture below). Steaming/curing takes approximately ½ hour. The contractor will be doing mainline lining the week of April 6th and may work a few days the week of April 13th, depending on the weather. After that, the contractor will start on manhole repairs.



The contractor will contact you prior to working on your lateral. At this time, lateral work is not scheduled to begin until the end of April, and scheduling is dependent on the weather.
