### 2023 ROAD PROJECTS

This summer Tetiva Road and Blackhawk Road will have some wedging work and will also be chip sealed. Privett Road will have the new culvert overlaid. Inama Road will be chip sealed. Hornung Road from Inama Road to Highway Y will have some wedging work and also be chip sealed. We don't have a specific start dates for these projects. The road construction companies are supposed to give notice to the residents prior to starting the work. Town Clerk will also post updates on the website as she is notified. Mussen Road is **closed to vehicle traffic** from the Mussen Road side and the Schoepp Road side. At this time there are no plans to reopen the current road location. Dane County is doing a Cultural Feature Study to determine if we can relocate the road to a new route.

**REMINDER: PLACE YOUR RECYCLING BINS OUT BEFORE 6:00 A.M. ON THE DESIGNATED MONDAY**

If you had your bin out by 6:00 a.m. and the recycling truck does not pick up your bin up by the end of the day on designated Monday, please call clerk by noon on Tuesday so she can report it to Waste Management.

You should have received a calendar from Waste Management in February with notice that the day has changed from Wednesday to Monday. Roxbury is the **Green Week** on Monday.

### ROXBURY LARGE ITEM/E-WASTE DROP OFF DAY:

There is going to be a Large Item/E-waste drop off day on September 23, 2023 at the town hall. **This drop off day is for Town of Roxbury residents only.** You may be asked to provide proof of residency, such as driver's license, utility bill, lease, etc. that shows your address in the Town of Roxbury. Watch the town website <https://town.roxbury.wi.us/> or outdoor bulletin board for more information on the time that drop off will be open and what items will be allowed to be dropped off. No drop offs the night before.

Item allowed include: furniture, rolled carpet and lumber (4' max length), mattresses/box springs, doors, wood windows, toilets, sinks, water softeners, humidifiers (NOT dehumidifiers)

E-waste (electronics) allowed include: computers, keyboards, monitors, printers, TV's etc.

Item not allowed include: tires, used oil, compost materials, dehumidifiers, batteries, fluorescent light bulbs, appliances

Hazardous materials (paint, pesticides, petroleum, products such as oil and solvents and explosives) are not acceptable. These items can be dropped off at the Clean Sweep program at 7102 US Hwy 12, Madison.
