

2026 SPECIAL ELECTION  
FOR MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE

Pursuant to authority granted by ordinance of the governing bodies of the Village of Prairie du Sac, the Village of Sauk City, and the Town of Roxbury, the Sauk Prairie Court Commission hereby orders a special election to fill the vacancy in the Office of Municipal Court Judge.

This vacancy was created on December 31, 2024, by the resignation of Judge Rick M. Koeck.


The elected candidate must be licensed to practice law in the State of Wisconsin and will serve the remainder of the unexpired term, ending April 30, 2027.

The special election will be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2026. If three or more candidates file, a special primary election will be held on Tuesday, February 17, 2026.

Nomination papers may be circulated beginning Monday, December 1, 2025, and must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 6, 2026. Candidates for Multi-Jurisdictional Judge file with the Sauk County Clerk's Office.

The Joint Municipal Court serves the Village of Prairie du Sac and the Village of Sauk City in Sauk County, and the Town of Roxbury in Dane County.
